

The Onondaga Cutoff is a fictional former-NYC bypass around the city of Syracuse, NY, as seen in bold above. The modeled portion includes the Onondaga Cutoff and M&E Railway. The Chicago Line is shown only for context. The Conrail operation is CTC controlled, highdensity, heavy-duty mainline railroading, as it appeared in the mid-1990's. The M&E operates using track warrants. Each session runs on a 3:1 fast clock for 12 scale hours—expect to be on duty for four hours once the clock starts. The layout is located at:

We operate with NCE radio throttles and also with 'WiThrottle' which is a free app on a smartphone. Please bring a small flashlight for night operations, an FRS radio if you have one, and throttle or smartphone if possible. NCE throttles must be set to Cab addresses 30-39 – speak with the General Manager to ensure. There are several throttles available for use.
